### NEW:

\$225 per person entry fee per two-person team.

Four fish per day, with two fish 28 inches or longer per team may be weighed in for the tournament.

FISHING BOUNDARIES: The Minnesota side of Lake of the Woods is open.

Fall Classic is limited to only 50 teams, so enter early or you won't get in.

You must fish out of the same boat both days. Only exception: boat or motor failure may allow you to change.

Entry Fee: \$450 per team, to include tournament registration as well as food tickets. Send entries along with check, or money order to North Star Walleye Classics, P.O. Box 976, Baudette, MN 56623. \* We do not accept credit cards for your tournament entry fee. \*

### TOURNAMENT RULES & WAIVER

TEAMS - Two person teams, must be 18 years of age or partners with a parent or legal guardian.

All Contestants must possess a valid Minnesota fishing license.

#### **Fall Classic**

Both Walleye and Sauger qualify - 15 inch minimum size limit with closed tail, 4 fish per boat per day. No fish are allowed to be possessed or will be weighed over 19 1/2 inches and less than 28 inches. Two fish 28 inches or longer may be weighed per team per tournament. This is not a catch and release tournament. Any fish judged not to be fresh (caught that day) will result in team disqualification. In the event of a tie, the biggest catch on Saturday will break the tie.

Equipment - All boats must be equipped with aerated live well or have a cooler with ice.

PFDs must be worn if the main combustion engine is running above idle speed.

All tournament boats may be checked at random by a judge's boat during the fishing day.

All tournament boats must be off the water by 4 p.m. Thursday.

Boats will be inspected starting with boat #1 at 8 a.m both days.

Boat #1 will leave first each day. We do not reverse the numbers the next day.

Team number is determined by entry date so the earlier you enter the earlier you will leave both days.

Boat inspection as well as starting and fishing of that day will be from the docks of Wigwam Resort, located 12 miles north of Baudette on MN St. Hwy #172. The Wheelers Point Public Access may be used for launching purposes, but all vehicles and trailers must be parked at Wigwam Resort.

Fishing Boundaries - All of the Minnesota Part of Lake of the Woods at the west end to Franz Jevne state park boat ramp on the Rainy River on the east end. Fishing is only allowed in Minnesota waters of Lake of The Woods, 4 Mile Bay and the Rainy River. Anyone caught outside of these boundaries will be disqualified for the day.

Any team that brings in a fish in the 19 1/2 through 28 inch slot will result in team disqualification.

All rulings made by the Tournament Director are final.
