Fishing Boundaries: The Minnesota side of Four Mile Bay, and the Rainy River is open. No fishing on the Lake is allowed.

Tournament is limited to 50 teams.

\$325 entry fee per two-person team.

Tournament Rules & Waiver

- **Teams**- Two person teams, must be 18 years of age or partners with a parent or legal guardian.
- **All contestants** must possess a valid Minnesota fishing license.
- **Both walleye and sauger** qualify. 14-inch minimum size limit with closed tail. Limit is 6 fish per boat. A maximum of 4 walleyes can be part of this 6 fish limit. No fish are allowed or will be weighed 19.5” or longer. This is not a catch and release tournament. Any fish judged not to be fresh (i.e. caught that day) will result in team disqualification. In the event of a tie, the biggest catch on Saturday will break the tie
- **Equipment**- All boats must be equipped with aerated live well or have a cooler with ice.
- **PFD’s** must be worn if the main combustion engine is running above idle speed.
- **All tournament boats** may be checked at random by a judge’s boat during the fishing day.
- **Boats** will be inspected starting with boat #1 at 8 am.
- **Boat #1** will leave first, both days.
- **Team number** is determined by entry date, so the earlier you enter, the earlier you will leave.
- **Boat inspection**, as well as starting and fishing of that day will be from the docks of Wigwam Resort, located 12 miles north of Baudette on Hwy 172. The Wheelers Point Public Access may be used for launching purposes, but all vehicles and trailers must be parked at Wigwam Resort.
- **Fishing Boundaries**- Fishing is only allowed in Minnesota waters of Four Mile Bay and the Rainy River. The first orange buoy inside the Light House Gap and the second orange buoy inside the “washout” are the west boundaries. The Franz Jevne State Park boat ramp on the Rainy River is the East boundary. No fishing on the lake is allowed. Anyone caught fishing outside of the boundaries will be disqualified for the day.
- **All rulings** made by the Tournament Director are final.
