Tournament Rules & Waiver

- Teams-** Two person teams, must be 18 years of age or partners with a parent or legal guardian.
 - All contestants** must possess a valid Minnesota fishing license.
 - Both walleye and sauger** qualify. 14 inch minimum size limit with closed tail. Limit is 8 fish per boat. A maximum of 6 walleyes can be part of this 8 fish limit. No fish are allowed or will be weighed 19.5” or longer. This is not a catch and released tournament. Any fish judged not to be fresh (i.e. caught that day) will result in team disqualification.
 - Equipment-** All boats must be equipped with aerated live well or have a cooler with ice.
 - PFD’s** must be worn if the main combustion engine is running above idle speed.
 - All tournament boats** may be checked at random by a judge’s boat during the fishing day.
 - All tournament boats** must be off the water by 4 pm Friday.
 - Boats** will be inspected starting with boat #1 at 8 am.
 - Boat #1** will leave first.
 - Team number** is determined by entry date, so the earlier you enter, the earlier you will leave.
 - Boat inspection**, as well as starting and fishing of that day will be from the docks of Wigwam Resort, located 12 miles north of Baudette on Hwy 172. The Wheelers Point Public Access may be used for launching purposes, but all vehicles and trailers must be parked at Wigwam Resort.
 - Fishing boundaries-**All of the Minnesota part of Lake of the Woods at the west end to Franz Jevne State Park boat ramp on the Rainy River on the east end. Fishing is only allowed in Minnesota waters of Lake of the Woods, 4 Mile Bay and the Rainy River. Anyone caught outside of these boundaries will be disqualified for the day.
 - Any team** that brings in a fish 19.5” or longer, will be result in team disqualification.
 - All rulings** made by the Tournament Director are final.
